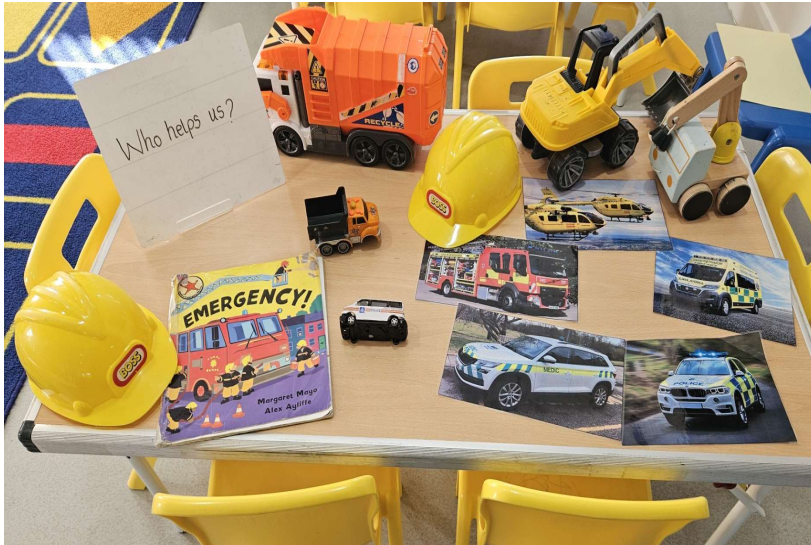




News Story – Emergency Service Day / World Coconut Day
