

News Story - International Peace Day

This week children have been looking at 'International Peace Day'. During registration, our toddler team have been focusing on getting children to think about how they feel. Saying "Assalamu alaykum" and how to reply to our friends. Staff have also been focusing on promoting good manners for example 'using kind hands' and 'sharing with our friends'.



Early in the week Preschool children have been looking at emotions and talking about how they feel. They then went on to create their own emoji to showcase their feelings. On Friday this then led on to Preschool children looking at the word 'peace'. Preschool staff expanded on the

word peace by looking at the sunnah's of our Prophet Muhammad (PBUH). They also

talked about how we can implement these sunnah's at home and within nursery. We talked about how we greet each other by saying "Assalamu alaykum". We also talked about how to keep clean, the importance of keeping clean, helping to tidy up after ourselves, using kind words when talking, using our "please" and "thank you" and how we treat our friends.





Children also focused on 'world peace'. They looked at the earth and talked about what the word 'peace' means and expanded on its meaning for better understanding. Children were asked 'what brings them peace!?'. Children grasped the word well and were able to respond "mummy gives me hug", "my friends" and "kind words". Children went on to paint their own earth and stuck on phrases that bring them peace and make them feel happy and loved.
