toddlers have focused on creating their own bus to role play with.

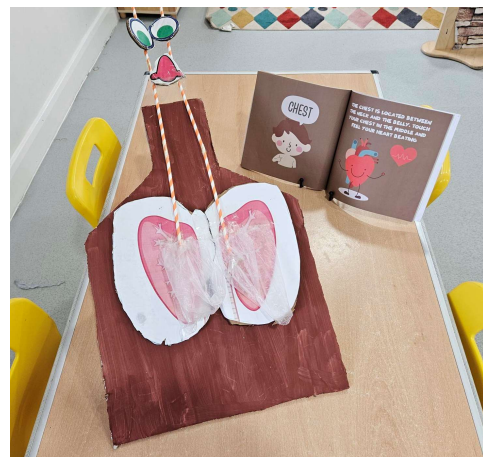
They have had fun all week working together gluing, sticking and especially painting the different parts of the bus and then assembling it all together.

Our Pre school children have really enjoyed taking part in daily 'belly breathing' exercises and learning about the body over the last couple of weeks. The staff have extended their learning by creating a model of the lungs. From this, children were able to understand 'where in the body the lungs are', 'how many lungs they have' and 'how they work'.

Children have been introduced to new words "inflate" and "deflate". Children have thoroughly enjoyed this activity and learning what happens inside their own body!
