Last Autumn Term Learning Focus Autumn Term Sep-Dec 2024

Pre-School

Last term we have been focusing on the changes that have occurred in Autumn. We have been looking at the different colour of leaves and talking about what other changes have occurred in our environment. We also started work on our phonic sounds, shapes and number recognition. The children have settled in well and are doing some brilliant work.







Toddlers

Last term we have been focusing on helping our toddlers settle into the start of the academic year. We set up activities that encourage children to socialise with peers and communicate with others based on their interests, helping them settle in and become more comfortable whilst at nursery. We have also focused on fine motor skills and colour recognition throughout this term for the children to develop in these areas.

Nursery Funding

All babies aged 9 months onwards and 2-year-olds are eligible for 15 hours of free early education (working parents).

3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours of free early education per week. There is an additional 15 hours per week of free childcare available for families that meet the Government's eligibility criteria.

Application and Funding Process

You will need to apply online via HMRC, they have a dedicated helpdesk to support parents to apply if you are unable to apply online. The link to the website is below:

Eligible parents will be given a code which will be valid for 3 months, you will be asked to re-confirm your eligibility towards the end of the 3-month period. HMRC will send reminders to parents.

Start of Session

Backpacks

Please ensure your child brings his / her backpack into nursery on a daily basis. Backpack should include a spare change of clothes, wipes or nappies/pull up to use as and when needed. If your child is toilet training please ensure extra clothes are provided in case of accidents.

Nursery Clothing

If your child has borrowed spare clothes/shoes please could these be returned to nursery ASAP.

Lending Library

Lending library will be open again from the first week back. Please take 5 minutes out when dropping off your child to choose a book with them. Reading is a huge part of a child's development, this encourages language development as well as developing a child's imagination and understanding of the world around them.
