News Story – Squirrel Day



The children had fun playing with the make-your-own-soup tuff tray this week, which was linked to Squirrel Day. To prepare their own soup, children were urged to use a checklist to locate the components throughout the room. We discussed what we could see, including the various textures.

We discussed the various colours we could see, such as red, brown, orange, and yellow, and the toddlers thought the rice was hard and slippery. They also thought the acorns were large, spherical, hard, and the wooden sticks were long and rough.





Additionally, we introduced counting, in which the children had to select any number from 1 to 5 and then select the appropriate number of squirrels to place in the correct bowls. This helped them recognise numbers and do constant counting.
