

News Story - Autumn

The season Autumn has begun and children have had a lot of fun exploring the season through various activities at nursery. They have been going on walks, looking at their surroundings such as houses, the bus driving past, the different trees and they have enjoyed picking up leaves and acorns along the way to explore back at nursery.

We used leaves to create our Autumn themed city in our tuff tray, using trains, train tracks and animals. Children enjoyed role playing as they ride along the track. We created Autumn wreaths which the children took home to hang once dry.

Inspired by our walk, the children have been painting their own leaves using lolly sticks and cotton buds as well as making a hedgehog using our coffee-based playdough and mini sticks.
