To learn about 'World Post Day' the children crafted their own post boxes out of a big cardboard box, painted bright red and decorated with colourful paper and stickers.

Children carefully wrote letters to their families and friends, some with simple messages, others with doodles or small stories. Each letter was then placed in an envelope decorated with sparkling stickers and bright drawings.



Towards the end of the week the children enjoyed a short walk up to the Post Office where they identified a post box. Children thoroughly enjoyed this activity from 'creating and thinking' through to being able to identify what they have learnt.
