



News Story - Green Day



Today at nursery we took part in 'Green Day.' The children were filled with excitement as they explored a sensation of green activities for the day.

In the mark making area the children created their own green collage pictures using different types of materials. They used their creative skills and put together some

wonderful art pieces that shimmered with every shade of green.

In the messy area our water tray was transformed into a magical sparkly green sensation, with green materials such as soft feathers, netting, funnels, jugs and tiny sea animals. The children enjoyed dipping their hands in, scooping, pouring and picking out their favourite pieces.



In the tuff tray children searched carefully to find something green. Some found green leaves, some found toys and others spotted hidden objects tucked between the sensory materials. Over on the playdough table children used cutters, rollers and tools to shape and mould the green playdough. They enjoyed creating trees, frogs, snakes etc.

To end the session, we conducted a green treasure hunt. The children enjoyed exploring the room for green objects, tip-toeing, looking high and low and collecting as many green objects as they could find. By the end we had a whole basket full of little green treasures. During circle time we carried out a group discussion about our favourite colours and we learnt that the colour green was also liked by our beloved Prophet Muhammad (SAW). We discussed about how green reminds us of nature, peace and the beautiful things that Allah has created.
