



News Story - World Snow Day

To celebrate 'World Snow Day' the children enjoyed many Winter themed activities designed to inspire creativity and exploration. In the mark making area the children designed their own snowmen using a variety of colours, glue and tissue paper. This helped develop their fine motor skills whilst expressing their creativity.



In the messy area the children had fun exploring shaving foam, using their hands to create snowballs, and investigating different textures, sparking curiosity through sensory play. Whilst on the playdough table the children used their imagination to create snowflakes, strengthening their hand muscles and shaping skills.

Our toddlers had fun creating some snowball pictures, they enjoyed rolling paper balls in the tuff tray filled with shaving foam and then making some prints on paper.

As part of an ongoing interest in the toddler group (Elmer in the snow) the children also enjoyed mixing colour in cornflour (snow) and creating their own coloured gloop!
